RE: RWENJERU CAMPSITE MBARARA UGANDA LIMITED.


I wish to report to you that I carried out a site verification exercise on the site of the above mentioned CBO to determine the suitability of it to be registered as a CBO that is doing a recommendable work to the community as earlier requested by you. The following were the findings:-

- At the site were eight camping site huts thatched with grass.
- Trees growing in shrubs, planted ones of about four feet above ground were about sixty. However, on one side of the site there was well planned grown up planted trees that provide valuable shade.
- There was a 3 – stance pit latrine block with 2 urinals and 5- shower rooms under construction at a level of completion, other in put materials like doors, and plumbing materials were in place, more so was a pit for latrine construction on another side of the site which was 40 ft down ground.
- The site is connected to National Water and Sewerage Cooperation water line with two functional tap stands in place, more so three rain water harvesting tanks all with a capacity of 16,000 litres were of in place.
- About 5,000 hydro form bricks were at the site allegedly to be used to construct Banda's/ corteges for their visitors at the site.
- One house block at a level of ring beam that is meant to accommodate their general offices, security personnel offices and craft shop was in place.

- One residential house that is already shuttered with doors and windows meant for their American volunteers accommodation was in place and was the one currently housing their general office.
- There was a communication from Peace Corps Uganda that the volunteer posted to that CBO was to report for work on 8th April 2010.
- Their office was finished with an office desk, book shelf, five office chairs, three cautioned forms of-three seated, library materials about tourism were on their shelves.
- Three land titles of volume 2867 follo 8 dated 19/ 12/ 2000, volume 2687 follo 9 date 7th match 2001 and volume 2853 follo 12 dated 19/ 12/ 2000 all of lease hold register number LRV. 111717 and in the names of Rwenjeru farm limited of p.o box 607 Mbarara were in place and their owner Mzee Begumisa told me that he gave that land to the CBO to turn the land into a campsite.
- The site was cleared, slashed and with a community access road, a cemented washing bay but not yet roofed or sheltered. More so was a kinyankole mud and wattle hut meant for housing the campsite canteen.
- Fully paid up members are 115 and each member paid up 100,000= . This money was their initial capital.
- The CBO was registered as an incorporated CBO on 15th/ 7/ 2005 with the Uganda registrar of companies as '**Rwenjeru campsite Mbarara (Uganda) limited**' but it had not registered with Biharwe sub county and Mbarara district.

Basing on findings, I feel satisfied and convinced that the CBO is doing a recommendable work to the community and here by recommend that it be registered with the sub county and the district as a CBO.
